Policy

Oceania Athletics Association aims to use world's best practice in risk management to support and enhance our activities in all areas of our organisation. We will ensure risk management is an integral part of all our decision-making processes.

Oceania Athletics Association will use a structured risk management program to minimise reasonably foreseeable disruption to operations, harm to people and damage to the environment and property. We will identify and take advantage of opportunities as well as minimising adverse effects.

Oceania Athletics Association will train our people to implement risk management effectively. We will strive to continually improve our risk management practices.

Responsibilities

The Executive Director is accountable to Council for the implementation of the risk management process and ultimately responsible for the management of risks in the business.

The Executive Director and is responsible for the development of and continual review of the Oceania Athletics Association risk management process.

All personnel, employees or volunteers are responsible for managing risks in their areas.

Process

Risk management procedures comply with and are based on Australian Standard AS/NZS 4360:1999.

The Executive Director is responsible for establishing timelines for review of risk register and then subsequently risk assessments.

Monitoring and Review

The Oceania Athletics Association Council will monitor and review the implementation of the risk management program.
