



RULES AND REGULATIONS

FULL AND HALF MARATHON

TAHITI – MOOREA MARATHON 2017





Article 1 : The event

The 29th annual Tahiti-Moorea Marathon is a big sportive event organized on Saturday, March 25th, 2017 in Moorea by Moorea Events association under the aegis of the French Polynesia Athletics Federation (FAPF), under the high employers of Moorea-Maiao city hall, the Ministry of Youth and Sports and his private partners.

Article 2 : The courses

The full marathon and the half marathon are races in competition at statutory distances respectively of 42.195 km and 21.100 km.

Article 3 : Departure

The departure of both races is given at 05:30 am from Temae near the P.K 0 (Total gas station) for a common arrival onto the public beach of Temae.

Article 4 : Provisionings

The organizer installs refreshment stations as follows on the course :

- in water approximately every 2.5 km
- in water, fruits and sponges approximately every 5 km.

No other provisioning is authorized between these stations at the risk of disqualification by the referee after a warning. An athlete can have his own provisioning but he has to plan to give it to the organization before race departure with his race number written on and the refreshment station where to drop off one or several provisionings. Fresh water is available at the starting end the finishing lines.

Article 5 : Support

Following athletes on foot, bicycle or any other means of transportation is formally prohibited at the risk of disqualification by the referee after one single warning.

Article 6 : Abandonment

Any abandonment, voluntary or following a physical incapacity (faintness, wound,...) displaces the runner. In case of abandonment, the runner in fact statement(declaration) to the closest race official.

Article 7 : Penalties

The following penalties are rigorous :

- Disloyal operation to the other competitors or the organization : put out of the race
- Failure to respect safety instructions : put out of the race
- Failure to respect the course : put out of the race
- Loss of the race number : 45 mn penalty
- Fraudulent electronic manipulation of timing chips : put out of the race

Article 8 : Road safety on the course

For safety reasons, the participants owe necessarily :

- Run on the right side of the road ;
- Use bike paths when available ;
- Do not cut in the bends at the risk of disqualification by the referee after a warning.

Article 9 : Race time limit

The race time limit is fixed at 6 am. The competitors who will cross the finishing line after 6 hours of running will not be classified.

Article 10 : Technical regulations

The runners submit themselves to the technical regulation of the race which is the one of the I.A.A.F or / and FFA at the risk of disqualification. The points of the regulation and safety will be reminded by the referee of the event shortly before the departure.

Article 11 – Race modifications / deferral

The organizers reserve the right to modify the course if unforeseen circumstances force them to do so.

In case of bad weather, the race can be postponed. The organizing Committee makes the commitment to warn the participants by means of media 24 hours before the day of the competition.

In case of force majeure, he could also make a decision a few hours only before race departure.

No compensation can be required by the organizing Committee in case of modification or of adjournment of the races in these conditions.



Article 12 – Registration conditions – documentary evidences

The races are opened to all, dismissed and not dismissed in athletics :
 - for the half marathon from the Junior category : athletes been born in 1999 and before
 - for the full marathon from the category Hope : athletes been born in 1997 and before.

Athletes with license holder :

The license holders in athletics have to indicate their number of license FFA (French Federation of Athletics) on the registration form or during the registration on the www.klikego.com website.

The license holders in triathlon have to supply a copy of their license FTT id (Tahitian Federation of Triathlon) with the registration form or to join it during the registration on the www.klikego.com website.

Athletes without license holder :

For the not license holders, the presentation of a medical certificate mentioning " the absence of contraindication in the running in competition ", is compulsory. It has to date at least from one year to the date of the race and must be necessarily supplied with the registration form or on the site of registration www.klikego.com (the photocopy is accepted). The original can be returned after the race.

Foreign athletes :

The foreign athletes have to supply a medical certificate mentioning "the absence of contraindication in the running in competition" even if they are holders of a license of competition emitted by a federation affiliated to the IAAF. He must be drafted in English or translated into French, date from less than one year to the date of the race and be necessarily supplied with the registration form or on the website of registration www.klikego.com (the photocopy will be accepted). The original can be returned after the race.

No registration will be accepted or even handled without the medical certificate or the number of license FFA or the copy of the license FTT id.

Licenses issued from other federations or sports clubs are not accepted (soccer, goes has, swimming).

Article 13 - Registration

Website registration :

The athlete joins on-line from the event " Tahiti-Moorea Marathon on 2017 " available on the www.klikego.com platform
 The athlete fills his registration form on-line and joined(contacted) to his on-line file(case) the necessary documentary evidences (see Article 9) in the validation of its registration.
 Once the file completed, the athlete can make the on-line payment or go in a French Polynesia registration center to make the payment) (local check, money or transfer order).

French Polynesia registration center :

The paper registration forms are given in the partners offices of the event. They are also downloadable to be printed on the www.mooreamarathon.com website

The athlete fills his registration form and joins the necessary documentary evidences (see Article 9) in the validation of his registration.

Once the fill completed, the athlete goes(surrenders) in a French Polynesia registration center to make the payment (local check, money or transfer order).

Increase :

In the date mentioned in the present article, an increase of the registration amount is made as follows:

- 8 Euros for the website registration center
- 1000 XPF for the French Polynesia registration centers

Warning : no registration on race day. No registration by postal mail, the organizing Committee has no guarantee to receive it on time.

Article 14 – Bibs and race pack

The race packs which have bibs, will be to remove with an ID card or of the registration receipt according to the program mentioned in the article 13.

There will be no withdrawal bib on the race day.

The envelope contains the bib, 4 safety pins and the label of bag numbered to label your personal bags.

Any assigned bib is definitive. The race bib is compulsory for all the participants during the whole race. It must be placed in a readable way on the chest, with visible sponsors of the organization and the number.

A timing chip is programmed and attached to the bib. It must not be removed or manipulated in fraudulent purposes. The athletes having medical limitations to wear this type of chip have to inform necessarily the organizing Committee about it.

Article 15 : Personal belongings

A free transportation service of personal bags is set up. Bags are handed at race departure and have to contain the numbered label handed in the race pack.

Bags are to be retrieved on arrival to Temae with your race number.

The organizing Committee relieves of any responsibility in case of loss or of theft.

Article 16 : Timing

The timing is made in an electronic way by a certified provider hired by the organizing Committee and under the supervision of the technical officials of the FAPF.

Article 17 : Results

The temporary results are posted on the event website, that very day. The official results are communicated by the organizing Committee after validation of the FAPF and at the latest one hour after the end of the race.

Article 18 : Divisions

There is :

- A classification scratch men and women mattering for the Oceania championship marathon for the athletes participating in conformance with this championship
- a classification scratch men and women mattering for the Polynesia marathon championship for the athletes participating in conformance with this championship
- a classification scratch men and women for the Half marathon
- classifications by categories of ages men and women as follows:

Article 19 : Awards ceremony and prize giving

All the finishers have in memory a T-shirt Finisher, a mother pearl shell medal Finisher in the effigy of the race, the drink, the buffet of fruits and a meal (Tahitian food).

For both races :

- Medals will go to the first 3 men and to the first 3 women of the classification scratch
- Rewards in kind (ex : plane tickets, free accesses, diverse prizes) will go to the first 3 men and to the first 3 women of the classification scratch
- Prize Money will go to the first 3 men and to the first 3 women of the classification scratch.

Delivery of medals : all the participants who will mount the podium will necessarily have to dress the official T-shirt of the race.

The prize-giving of the Oceania and Polynesia championships is organized by the FAPF in partnership with the organizing Committee.

A drawing lots of diverse prizes will be organized on arrival.

Article 20 - Responsabilité civile

The organizing committee signed an insurance covering the pecuniary consequences of its civil liability, that of his volunteers and all the participants in Tahiti-Moorea Marathon on 2017. As regards the civil liability of the participants, the intervention of this insurance for the latter is limited to the accidents which they could cause on the occasion of the progress of the sportive event. This guarantee will intervene in complement or for lack of other insurances from which the participants could benefit besides.

The organizing committee disclaims all liability in case of damage (flight, loss, breaking ...) undergone by the private property of the participants even if it is given custody of it. Thus the participants cannot turn around against the organizer for any damage caused in their equipment. The subscription of an insurance guaranteeing these risks is within the competence of each.

Article 21 : First Aids

The cover of the first aids is insured by the Polynesian Federation of Disaster and emergency services which insures this touch according to the agreement signed with the organizing Committee.

Article 22 : Claim

In the case of a complaint, this one will have to be handwritten and sent to the referee accompanied with the sum of 5 000 FCP for the maximum deadline of thirty minutes after the proclamation of the official results. In case of not admissibility, 5 000 FCP will be kept by the organizing Committee.

Article 23 : Jury of appeal

In case of complaint, a jury of appeal gathered to study and return a notice on this one. This jury consists of 3 people : of the President of the Moorea Events Association, the Race Director and the Judge concerned by the motive for the complaint.

Article 24 : Acceptance of the regulation

By joining Tahiti-Moorea Marathon, every participant accepts the regulation of the races. The competitor makes a commitment on the honor not to anticipate the departure and to run the complete distance before crossing the finishing line. Should the opposite occur, he can be disqualified.

Article 25 : Mailing list

The registration in Tahiti-Moorea Marathon involves necessarily for the participant the subscription to the mailing lists of the Moorea Events Association.

Article 26 : Right to one's image

Every participating athlete authorizes de facto the organizers to use their image and name with the aim of assuring the promotion of the present event, the sport generally as well as the sponsors, and this whatever is the used support.
