



Athletes Commission

TERMS OF REFERENCE (TOR): SUMMARY

Status:

1. The OAA Athletes Commission is appointed by, and reports to, the OAA Council under clause 9.1 and 9.2 of the Terms of Reference.
2. The Athletes Commission is advisory to Council and is not entitled to make decisions for or on behalf of the OAA (refer to clause 1 of TOR).

Roles and Responsibilities

1. (As at 1.2 of the TOR in their entity, a-f)

Composition:

The Athletes Commission is composed of up to 7 members (including Chairperson) to ensure that the views of Athletes from all regions of Oceania are properly represented and that there is a balance of representation on the OAA Athletes Commission. The following will apply:

- a. There will be no more than 2 members from any one Member Federation.
- b. There will be no more than 3 Athletes Commission Members from any of the OAA Regions- Polynesia, Micronesia and Melanesia.

Eligibility:

(As at 3.3 of the TOR in their entity a-f)

Meetings:

1. The Athletes Commission shall meet in person at least once each year, usually around an OAA Championship, Regional Championship or other OAA activity (i.e. OAA Congress).
2. Their meetings are convened by the Chairperson through the OAA Staff Liaison.
3. The agenda and the working documents, as well as the minutes of the meeting, are prepared by the OAA Staff Liaison at the request of the Chairperson.
