

Oceania Teams Championships 2024:

The 2024 Oceania Athletics Championships will be conducted in Suva, Fiji, with the Championships to run from Saturday 1st June until Saturday June 8th.

Oceania Athletics will be conducting a Teams Championships, for U16 and U20 Teams. The teams' championships will be conducted alongside the Senior, Masters, Para and Under 18 Area Championships for the first time. With an event and championships conducted like this will be a first not only within the Area, but the World.

Suva, Fiji will be host, and has hosted two previous Oceania Masters Championships, as well as two previous Area Championships. It's fitting that Suva hosts the first Combined Championships, as it hosted the first Masters Championships in 1982 and Senior Championships in 1990. The Local Organising Committee is spearheaded by Athletics Fiji.

Event Divisions:

The competition will be held in the following Age Groups/Divisions:

- Women Under 16
- Women Under 20
- Men Under 16
- Men Under 20

Events:

Track	100, 200, 400, 800, 1500, 3000, Short Hurdles, Long Hurdles, Steeplechase
Field	Long Jump, Triple Jump, High Jump, Shot Put, Discus Throw, Javelin Throw.
Relays	4x100, Swedish Medley (100m, 200m, 300m, 400m)

Age Groups:

U16	Athletes will need to be 13, 14 or 15 years old to compete
U20	Athletes will need to be 16, 17, 18 or 19 years old to compete

Age taken as of the 31st of December in the year of competition (2024).

Eligibility:

The Oceania Teams Challenge is open to any registered team or school in Oceania. All teams must be in good standing with their Member Federation and OAA will have final approval of any team entered.

Teams can enter a maximum of 20 athletes per team.

Entries and Competition Fee:

Final entries will be due Friday 3rd of May 2024. Competition Fee is 350AUD per team.

Team Managers will need to enter via the online portal. No additional entries will be accepted after the close of entries date.

During the entry process on the entry portal, managers will need to enter the Name and Date of Birth of all athletes in the team up to the maximum number of 20.

Once the Team Manager has completed the entry portal and paid the entry fee, OAA will send through the Final Entry Form, where Teams can enter athletes into individual events.

Final Entry Forms need to be completed the close of entries.

Accreditation:

All team members will need to be accredited. Teams will receive accreditation for two (2) Team Managers.

An Additional two (2) Accreditation can be purchased for 150AUD per person.

Safeguarding:

As a part of Oceania Athletics safeguarding measures. All athletes will need to complete the Oceania Athletics Athlete Declaration and Consent Form. These forms will send to all Teams along with the event entry form.

All Accredited persons for the Oceania Athletics Championships, will need to complete the World Athletics Safeguarding Essentials Course on the World Athletics eLearning Platform. If a person is unable to complete prior to arrival, OAA will have computers available for persons to use.

Closing Ceremony/Prizegiving:

Oceania Athletics will hold a closing ceremony and dinner on Saturday 8th of June, after the competition concludes.

Teams will be able to attend, and information on cost and venue will be sent out closer to the competitions.
